Famagusta Gate, the most significant of the gates of Venetian Nicosia, opened onto the road that led to the most important harbour town of the island, hence its name. It was originally known as 'Porta Giuliana' in honour of Giulio Savorgnano, the engineer who designed and erected the Venetian walls.

Built in the 18th century, the ancient Aqueduct was part of the old water supply system of Nicosia which brought water from the mountains north of the city. This section of the aqueduct was known as the Silihtar Aqueduct, after the Ottoman governor of the time. A prime example of 16th century military architecture. They were built of mud - brick, with the lower part only buttressed by stone. The walls contain eleven pentagonal bastions with rounded orillons and protected by an 80 metres wide moat. The bastions are named after eleven families, pillars of the Italian aristocracy of the town, who donated funds towards the construction of the walls.
